**Guest speaker – Mike Evans:**

Born 1957 and raised in Lexington, Kentucky – Attended Bryan Station High School ~ graduating in 1975; attended Seminole Community College 1980-82.

I never really attended church anywhere while growing up.

I worked as over-the-road truck driver for several years before taking a job as process engineer at Guardian Automotive in Morehead in the 1990s.

I met my wife, Rosanne, through mutual friends and while dating, started attending church services with her at Queen Street church of Christ (which is now Rolling Hills church of Christ). We were married in June, 1998. After reading/ studying the Bible and re-evaluating my first baptism, I was re-baptized to assure my baptism was scriptural.
